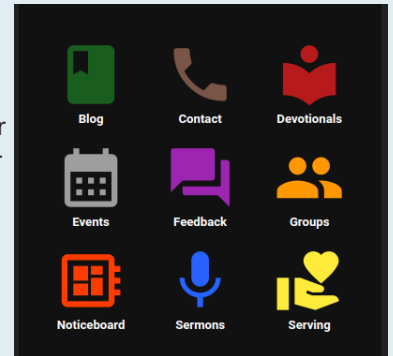
## From the Minister's Desk

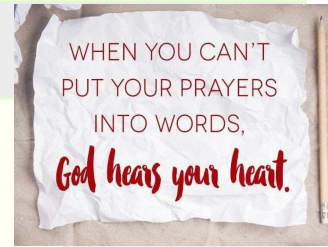

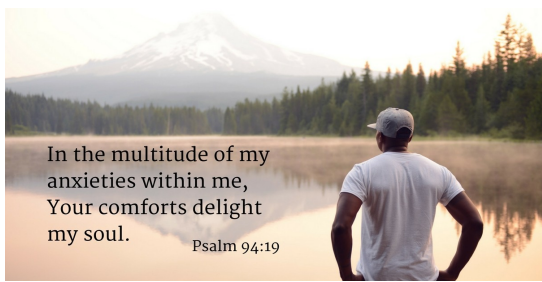
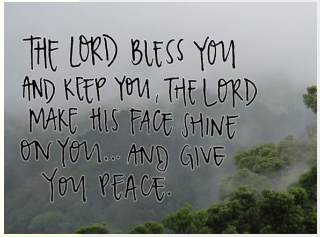
